'The Bell Rings For Everyone!' Program Ending Gala, Here and Over the Border

In this program the Down Association invites more and more schools to join its integration resolution. Among the schools we find specialised, segregated schools and normal schools at the same time. During the integration program, 10-12 weeks, disabled children were taken to normal schools, kindergartens by their special education teachers. They spent there 1.5 hours together with healthy students. They were practising for a final performance or producing a small exhibition that they acted out or exposed in the National Theatre, Budapest, and also in the country, in Debrecen and in Nyíregyháza. The program left Hungary, the same gala was organised in Romania, "Clopotelul suna pentru toti" and in Ukraine, "Дзвінок звучить для всіх!"
