Dear EDSA members,

I have to confess that there was not a lot of communication from my side towards EDSA in the last months. But we had an extremely busy time here in our centre. We published a new book in february, I translated it from norwegian to german. The title: "Are we youngsters or do we have DS?" It was presented with a special event in february. In march – probably like all of you – we were tied up with the work around the WDSD. It is a good idea to celebrate this special day but if gives a lot of work. This year we produced a special stamp, besides organising different other activities.



The main product however was a booklet in easy language that comes together with a dvd (33 minutes) and is called "Down-Syndrom and I". Five young adults with ds explain in the film, what ds is and what it means to their life. The same text can be found in the booklet. This information is especially designed for teenagers and adults with ds, but can be used for others as well. We presented the film as well as our awards on 25th march, there were over 200 guests and some good articles in the press.
