

Activity Name:

What do I need to do to watch a film in the cinema?

Educational area of reference:

Communication, orientation, use of money, use of stores

Goals / Objectives:

- Knowing how to choose a film
- Knowing where to buy tickets
- Knowing how to pay for tickets & snacks
- Knowing what is the right place to watch the film
- Knowing where to go when the film is over

Number of participants:

3-5 participants

Time needed:

4 hours (depending on the film)

Description:

- In a previous meeting, the participants of this activity have to look trailers or film descriptions to decide which film they want to see. Contacting the cinema to know the costs for ticket + snacks and the schedule time of the film could facilitate the planning of the activity (money to bring, appointment to fix,...)
- The appointment for participants is at the entrance of the cinema.
- Inside the cinema, the participants have to look for a ticket box.
- At the ticket box everyone asks for a ticket for the film XY and pay by cash or by credit card for the own ticket.
- Everyone needs to take care of its own ticket. (wallet)
- Pitstop to toilet before the film is starting.
- After having the ticket, they will go to the right movie theatre, the snack bar included.
- Everyone has to look for a seat (depending on the reservation mood)
- Now everyone can enjoy the film.
- When the film is over, everyone needs to collect all its stuff and look for the exit.
- The group is leaving the cinema, where they meet at the beginning and everyone is going home or somewhere else.
