

Activity Name:

I will send you a present by the post shop.

Educational area of reference:

Communication, orienteering in the street, use of money, use of stores.

Goals / Objectives:

- Know where the post shop is, where you must go to
- Preparing in advance the address where the parcel has to be send to
- Thinking to take your parcel you want to send with you
- Being able to communicate your wish to the post shop worker
- Paying the bill to send your parcel

Number of participants:

1- 3 participants

Time needed:

4 hours with a repetition on another day

Description:

- The participants are meeting during a weekday in the afternoon because the post shop isn't open on the weekends.
- First, the participants are going to the post shop to ask what they need to send a parcel:



1. A gift the participants want to send.



2. A person, who the participants want to send the parcel to – so the participants also need the address of that person.



3. A parcel to put the gift inside or buying the box directly at the post office.



4. A post shop, where the participants can go to send our parcel, buy the parcel box or the stamp.



5. Money to pay to the post shop who is going to send our parcel.

- After having chosen our gift, the participants must check the address of the person the participants want to send the parcel to.
- Then the participants need to write properly an in the correct form the address on the box of our parcel. When the participants don't have a box, the participants need to take with us the address to note it directly at the post office.
- The way to write the address correctly:

First Name + Last Name

Number, street name

Post code, name of the town

Country

- Then the participants are going to the post office to bring our parcel. During our way to the post office the participants are going to make photos of the street, where you need to go.
- At the post office the participants are going to wait for our turn, maybe depending on the post shop, the participants need to take a ticket with a number.
- When it's our turn, the participants are asking the post (wo-)men, what the participants need to do to send our parcel.
- The participants will give the parcel to her/him and are going to pay the bill.
- The participants are going to say thank you for this service and taking the bill with us at home.
- The participants are going back to our home.
- In a second time, our participants are going to send a parcel totally on their own. The photos the participants made during our first training will be printed and filled in a document, so they can use it like a map. When they are lost somewhere, they can ask people around the streets for help by showing on the photos, where they need to go to.
